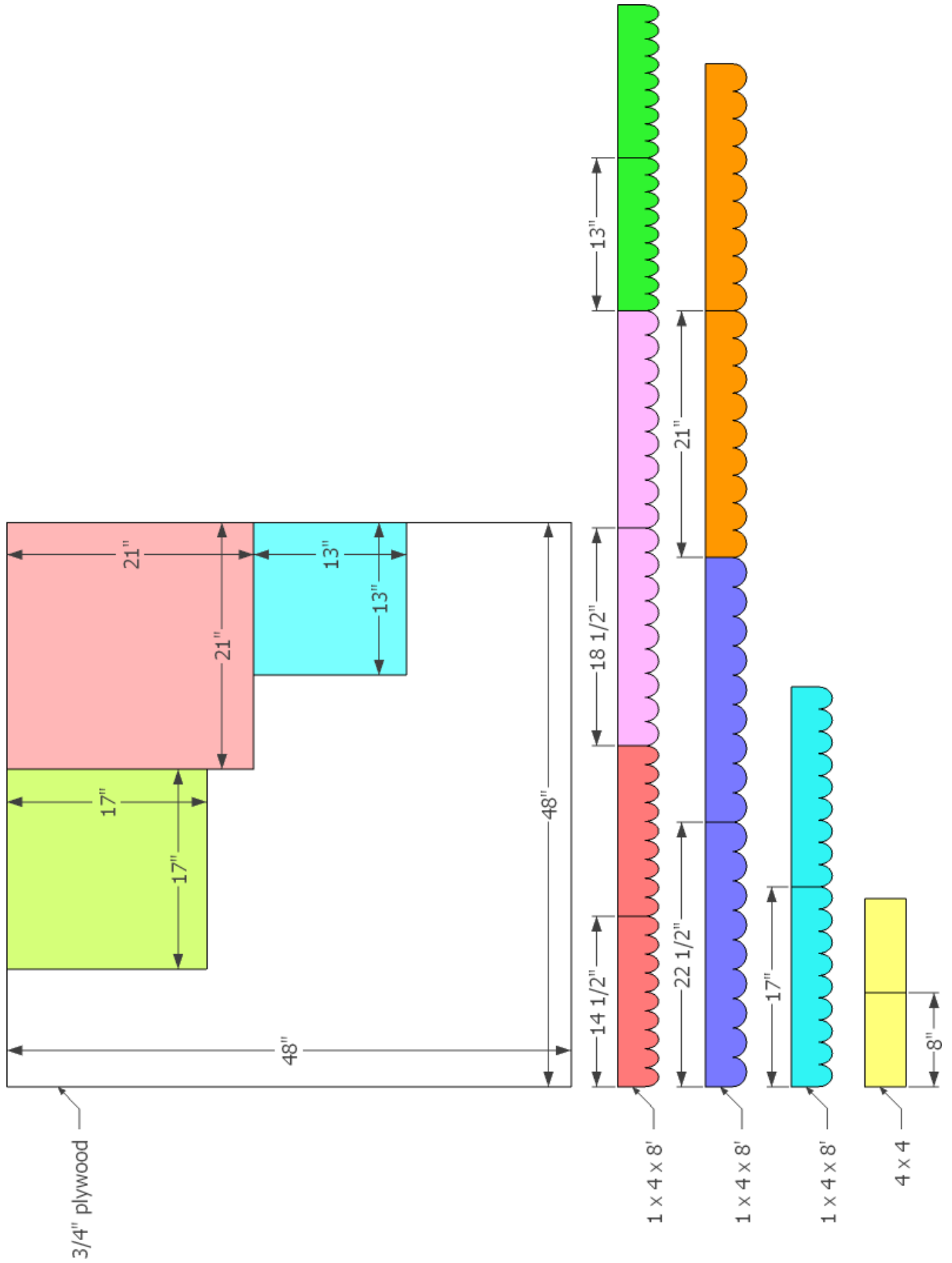

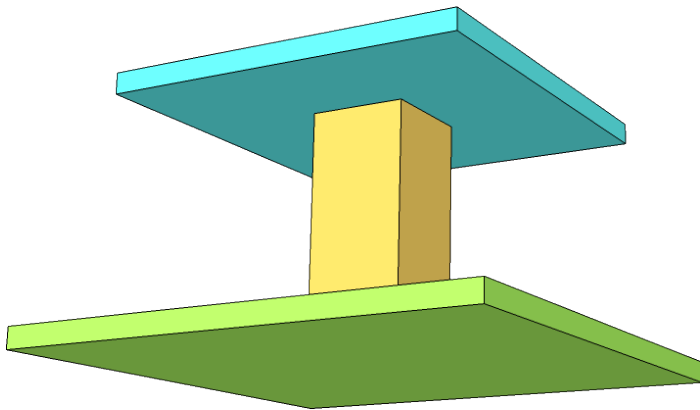
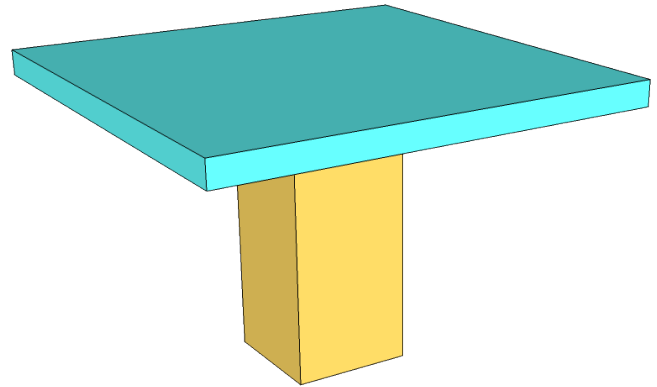
Supply List

Item	Quantity	Description
48" x 48" x 3/4" plywood	1	
1 x 4 x 8'	3	Or less if you have scraps!
4 x 4 x 4'	1	Or less if you have scraps!
2" wood screws	handful	
Wood glue		
Brad nails or staples	handful	
Finish of choice

Use wood glue at every joint in this project. Pre-drill and screw through the top shelf into one of the 4 x 4 pieces. Make sure all of the 4 x 4 pieces are centered in this project.

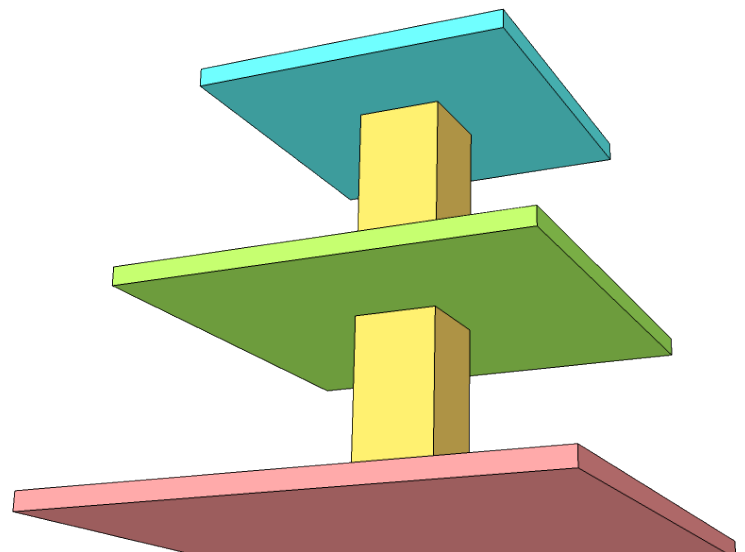

Pre-drill and screw through the middle shelf into the top 4 x 4 board.

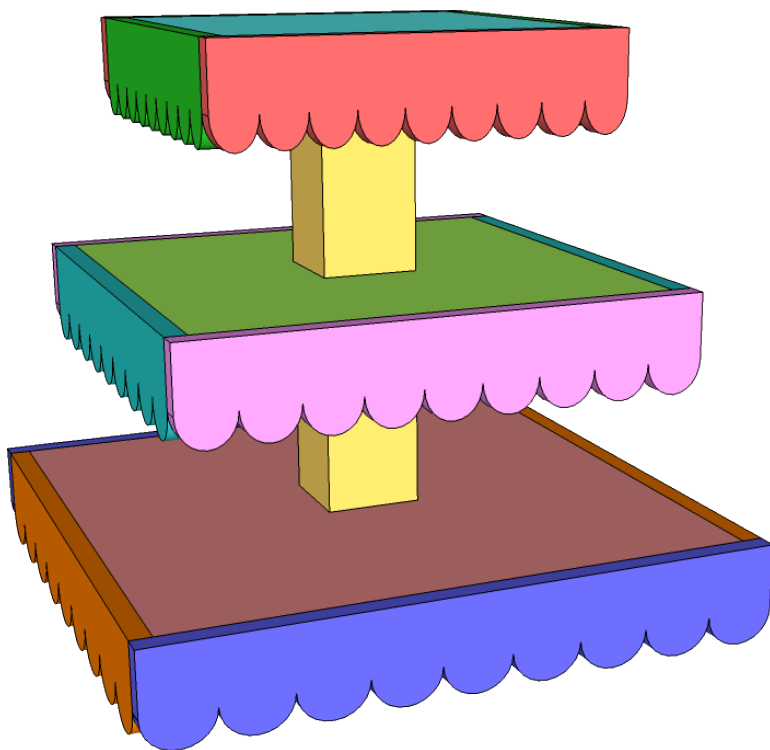
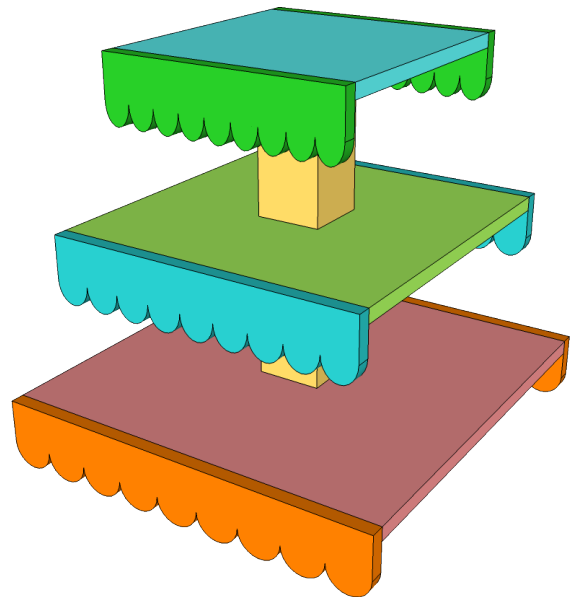

Next, attach the lower 4 x 4 board to the middle shelf from below by pre-drilling at an angle through the 4 x 4 board and into the shelf above. Use one screw on at least two sides of the 4 x 4. Finally pre-drill and attach the lower shelf to the bottom of the lower 4 x 4 board.

Use glue and your Airstrike stapler to attach the short 1 x 4 trim boards to the sides of your shelves. A decorative edge of your choice can easily be added to these boards with a jigsaw before you attach them.

Finally add the longer 1 x 4 trim boards to the other sides. Fill any staple and screw holes, sand, and finish as you wish! This is a super easy project that anyone can do and if you decide to make one of your own be sure to stop by our website and let us know!
