


Floating TV Shelves

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Supply List


Item	Quantity	Description
1 x 12 x 8'	1	Pine or whitewood board
1 x 12 x 4'	1	Pine or whitewood board
1 x 8 x 8'	2	Pine or whitewood board
2 x 4 x 10'	2	Pine or whitewood board
2-1/2" pocket hole screws	20	
1-1/4" pocket hole screws	57	
1-1/4" wood screws	12	
3.5" Torx or wood screws	12	To attach to the wall studs. At least 6 per shelf
Wood glue


Secure the short 2 x 4 boards to the long 2 x 4 board with wood glue and 2-1/2" pocket hole screws. The spacing isn't critical. Pre-drill mounting holes in the long 2 x 4 according to the wall studs where this will hang.

Attach it to the wall studs with at least 6 3-1/2" screws.





Start the cover assembly by attaching the short 1 x 8 pieces to the end of the 1 x 12 board with wood glue and 1-1/4" pocket hole screws. Make sure the remaining pocket holes are facing the same direction.







Attach the long 1 x 8 board to the front of the cover assembly with wood glue and 1-1/4" pocket hole screws.

Slide the cover over the already installed 2 x 4 supports. Secure it with at least 6 1-1/4" wood screws through the top. I've made this image a little transparent so you can see how it will all fit together.
