



2 x 12 x 6'	1	Pine or whitewood board
2 x 10 x 8'	1	Pine or whitewood board
2 x 3 x 6'	2	Pine or whitewood board
2-1/2" pocket hole screws	32	
Wood glue		
Finish of choice		
3" wood screws	4	For attaching the feet


Drill pocket holes for 2-1/2" pocket hole screws as indicated by the arrows.



Notch detail for the legs. Feel free to use whatever design you want on the legs. Use a jigsaw or a bandsaw to cut the notches out. Be careful and go slow to get the best results here!



This project will be built upside down.
Use wood glue at every joint in this project. Attach the rails to the legs with 2-1/2" pocket hole screws. Make sure the pocket holes are on the inside.





Attach the assembly from step 1 to the bottom of the top board with 2-1/2" pocket hole screws.

Add the center board with 2-1/2" pocket hole screws. The center board gets two pocket holes on each end of the bottom face to attach to the legs.

Secure the feet with 3" wood screws. Make sure to countersink these so they don't scratch your floor! Sand and finish as you wish! If you make one of these be sure to stop by our website and let us know!
