


## **SUPPLY LIST**


Item	Quantity	Description
2x3x8	6	cedar
2 1/2" finish nails		
wood glue		





## **CUT LIST**






Start by making all of your cuts. Then drill 1 1/2" pocket holes into all of the short pieces. Start by assembling the base with wood glue and 2 1/2" pocket hole screws.




Now build the remaining 9 squares with wood glue and 2 1/2" pocket hole screws.




Lay the base with the pocket holes down. Then place a square directly on top of it. Turn the second square so that the short piece is visible. This will give the planter the staggered pattern. Attach with wood glue and 2 1/2" finish nails.





Continue with the third square. Turn it so that it matches the direction of the base square and attach with wood glue and nails.





Now add the 4th square the same way. Continue with the remaining squares.
