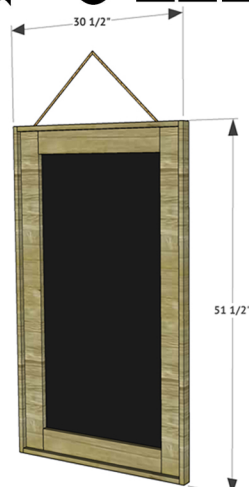




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HANGING CHALKBOARD



SUPPLY LIST

Item	Quantity	Description
1x4x8	1	pine or whitewood
1x4x6	2	pine or whitewood
1x2x8	2	pine or whitewood
2' x 4' chalkboard panel	1	1/4" thick mdf chalkboard
wood glue		
5/8" nails		
1.25" nails		
1.25" pocket hole screws	8

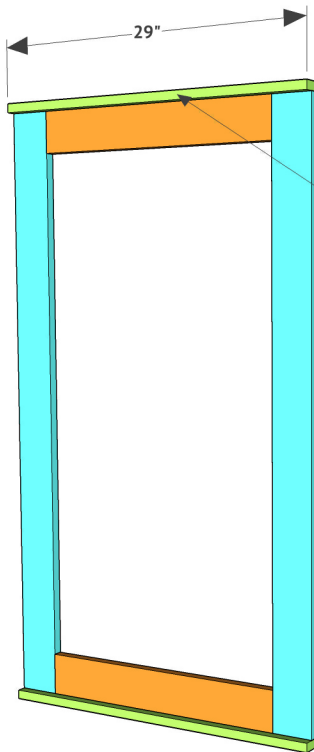
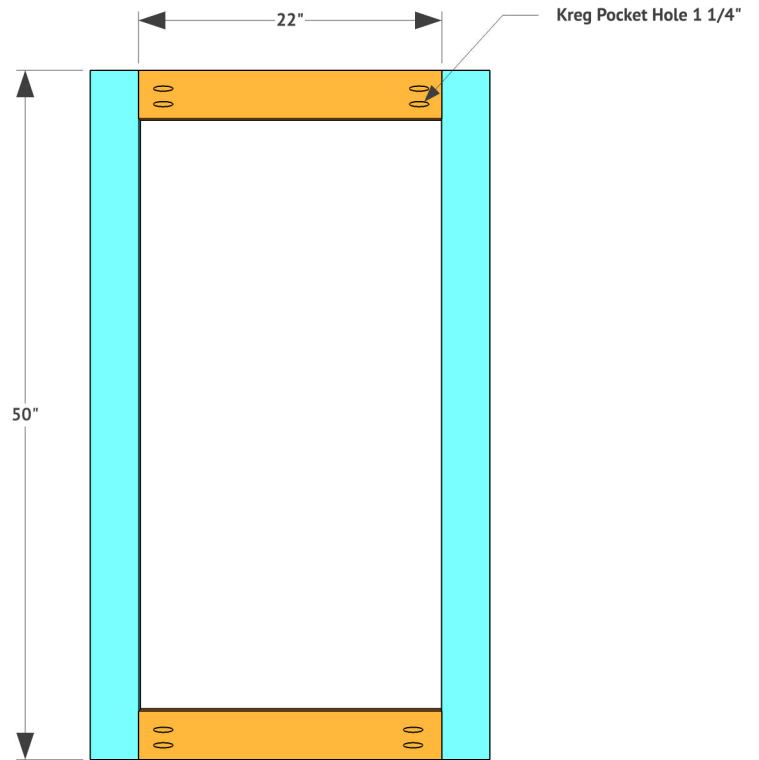
CUT LIST

After making your cuts, and adding 3/4" pocket holes, attach the short boards to the long boards with 1.25" pocket hole screws through the pocket holes.

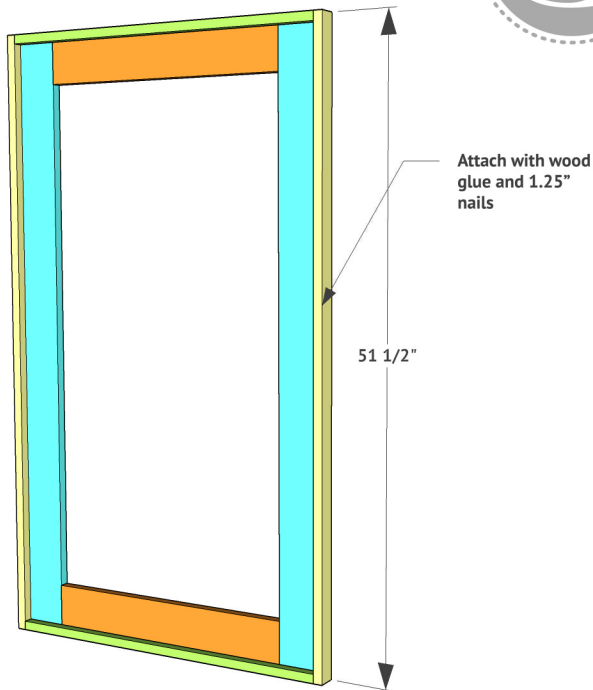

Now attach the top trim pieces using wood glue and a nail gun. We used 1.25" nails on this part. The trim pieces should sit 1/4" past the back of the frame. This will make them sit flush with the wall once you add the chalkboard panel.

Now attach the longer trim pieces down the sides of the chalkboard. These will also be attached with wood glue and 1.25" nails.

Final step! Turn the frame over and attach the panel to the back of the frame using wood glue and 5/8" nails around the entire panel.

Attach with 5/8" nails around entire panel.
