



1x3x4	1	Pine
swivel casters	4	Link to Casters in Post
1 1/4" Brad Nails		
1 1/4" pocket hole screws		
Wood Glue





CUT LIST



1

Cut and assemble each leg. Attach the 1x4 to the 1x3 with wood glue and 1 1/4" brad nails. Nail from the front of the 1x4 into the 1x3. Do this x4.





Cut the boards for the bottom frame. Drill 3/4" pocket holes into the short pieces. Attach with wood glue and 1 1/4" pocket hole screws.

Assemble the top frame the same way as the bottom frame but add one more short piece to the middle of the frame.





Attach a leg to each corner of the bottom frame. The bottom of the frame will be flush with the bottom of each leg. Attach with 1 1/4" brad nails and wood glue.

Cut the bottom planks to fit then attach both end pieces. The end pieces will fit against the inside of the legs. Attach with 1 1/4" brad nails and wood glue.



Attach the rest of the bottom planks. Evenly space them and attach with brad nails and wood glue.

Mine were $1\frac{1}{8}$ " apart.




Attach the top frame $\frac{3}{4}$ " down from the top of the legs.

Use $1\frac{1}{4}$ " brad nails and wood glue.




Cut the top planks to fit then attach them to the top frame with 1 1/4" brad nails and wood glue. Make sure to also nail the planks into the middle support on the frame.


Flip the table over and attach the 3" caster blocks to the bottom of the coffee table. These will fit on the bottom planks and against the inside of the bottom frame.

Attach the casters to the caster blocks.
