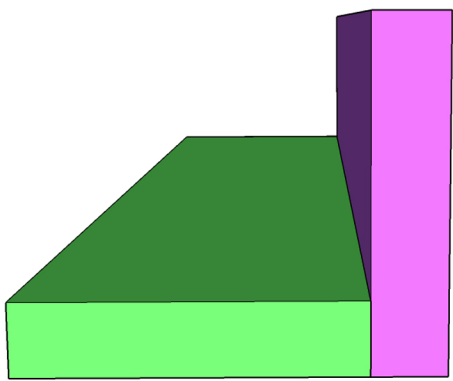

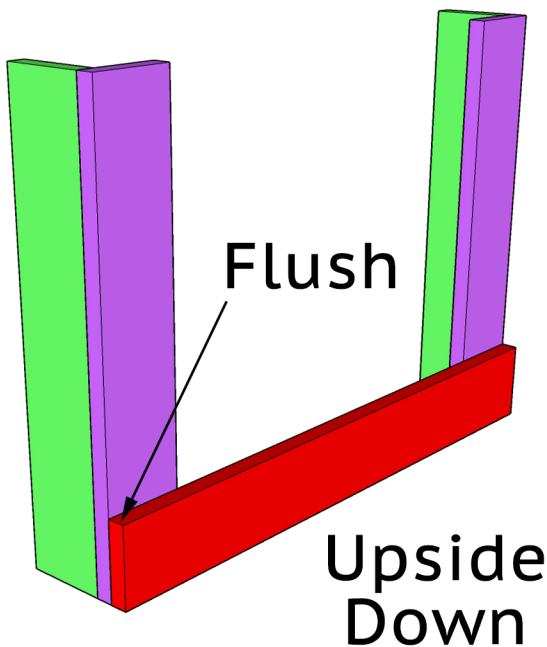

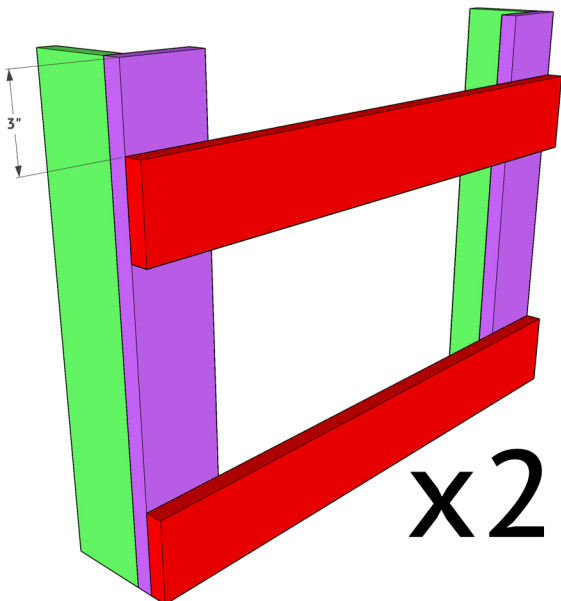

After making all cuts, begin assembling the legs. Attach two leg pieces together, so that they form an "L". with 1 1/4" brad nail and wood glue. Build four legs.

Attach a short apron piece to the edge of both legs. Make sure that the apron is attached to the side of the leg without the seam and that it is flush with the edge of the legs.

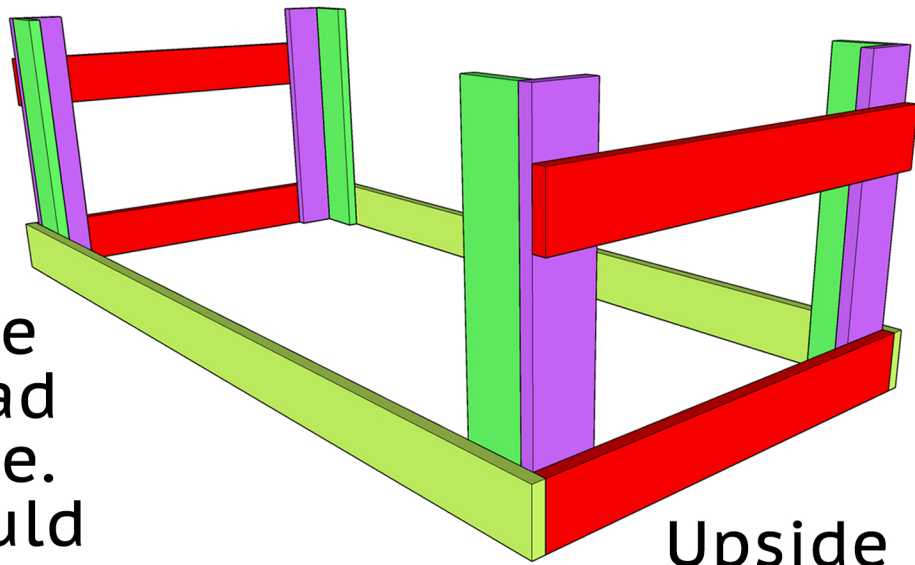

Attach another short apron piece, 3" from the other end of the legs, with 1 1/4" brad nails and wood glue. Build two sides.

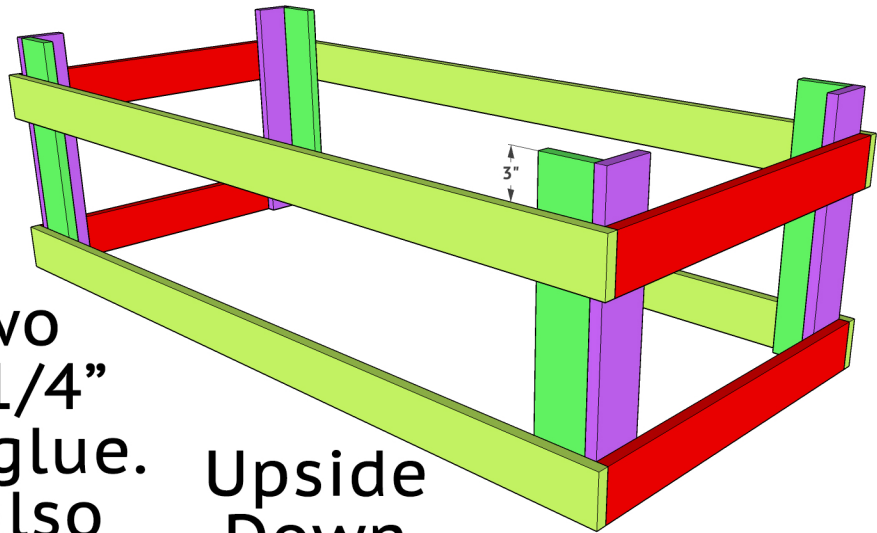
Attach two long apron pieces, to the legs, with 1 1/4" brad nails and wood glue. The long apron should be flush with the short apron.

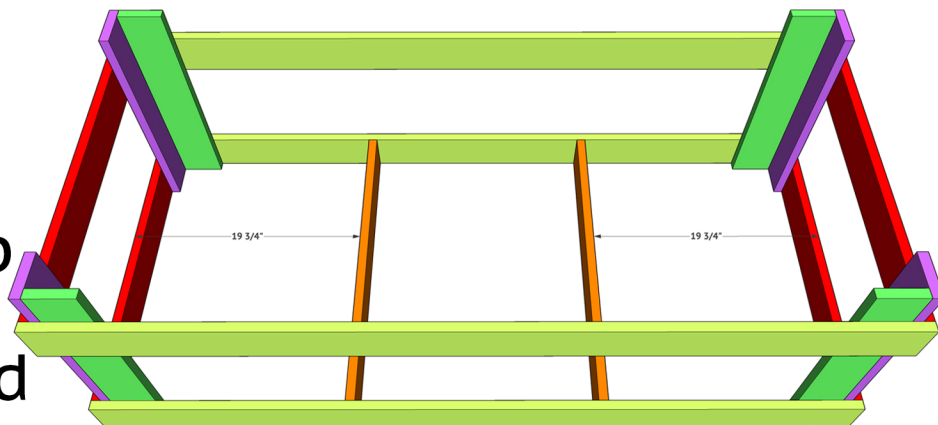
Attach the other two long aprons with 1 1/4" brad nails and wood glue. The aprons should also be flush with each other.

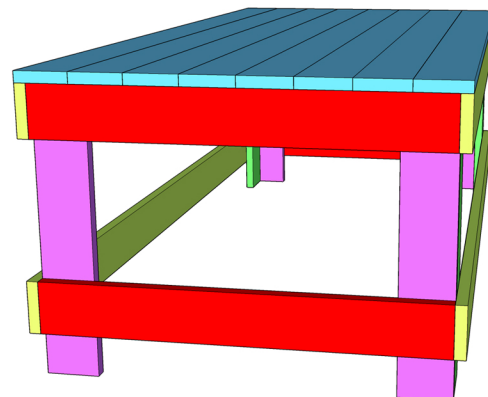
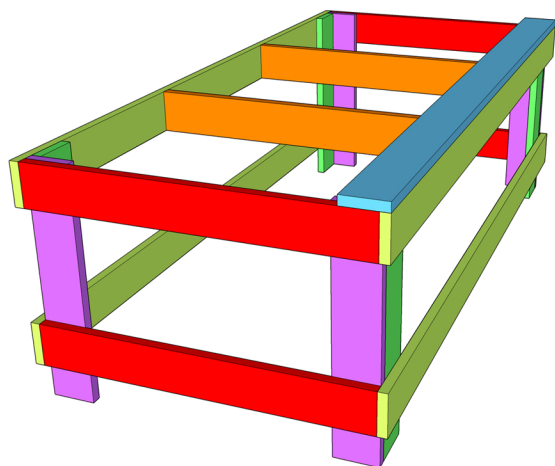
Attach the middle supports to the top apron with 1 1/4" brad nails and wood glue, from the apron and into the supports.

Flip the table right-side-up and attach the top slats. Start on one side and work your way to the other. Use 1 1/4" brad nails and wood glue.
