Step one is ripping your boards and making cuts. The top of the table is 2x6 boards that we ripped to 5" each with our table saw. If you don't rip your boards, make sure to adjust the cuts on the next step. These are 1.5" pocket holes, and you will attach all aprons together using 2.5" pocket hole screws. Make sure all of your pocket holes are facing up and going in the right direction.

Next, attach your aprons. These are 2x4 boards that we ripped to 3" each. Miter each edge to 45°, and attach them through the remaining pocket holes on the planks and into each apron. Make sure to add a line of wood glue under each apron on this part as well. The top of the aprons will be flush with the top of the planks.

Now add the foot pads. These are 1x6 boards that are cut to 5" long each. Attach one to each corner of the table base using wood glue and 1.5" wood screws.

After you have those attached, you can attach each hairpin leg to the foot pads, then flip it over and add the finish to the wood.
