

1X2X8	4	Pine or Common Boards
1 1/4" Finish Nails		
2 1/2" Finish Nails		
Wood Screws		
Wood Glue


CUT LIST






Attach a 1x2 to a 1x4 to create an "L". Use wood glue and 1 1/4" finish nails.

Do this 2 times.




Measure and cut the headboard slats to fit. Attach them to the back of the "L" pieces with 1 1/4" finish nails and wood glue.






Flip the headboard over. Measure and cut the top trim to size.

Attach it to the top of the headboard with 1 1/4" finish nails and wood glue.





Measure and cut the diagonal trim pieces to size. Center them on the top of the headboard and attach with 1 1/4" finish nails and wood glue.





Attach a cleat to a side piece with 1 1/4" finish nails and wood glue. The headboard end should be flush. Do this for both sides.




Note: These assemblies should be mirror images of each other.



Attach the foot board piece to the end of the side pieces. Use 1 1/4" finish nails and wood glue.











Attach the end trim piece with 1 1/4" finish nails and wood glue. The inside of the trim piece should be flush with the inside of the bed frame.





Measure and cut the side trim pieces to fit and attach them with 1 1/4" finish nails and wood glue.



Attach the headboard to the bed frame with 2 1/2" finish nail, from the back of the headboard and into the bed frame.
