





2 1/2" pocket hole screws		






Note: We ripped the round edges off of the 2x6 boards to make them 5" wide. This is not a necssary step. If you choose not to ripyour round edges, please adjust the measurements for the table top.









Attach the next set of planks with 2 1/2" pocket hole screws. Every other pocket hole should face in, starting with the ends.






Use a plunge router attached to a jig and cut a 48" circle. Cut with the bottom of the planks facing up. You can see how we made our jig on the post on our website.





Attach four hairpin table lets to the bottom of the table top.
