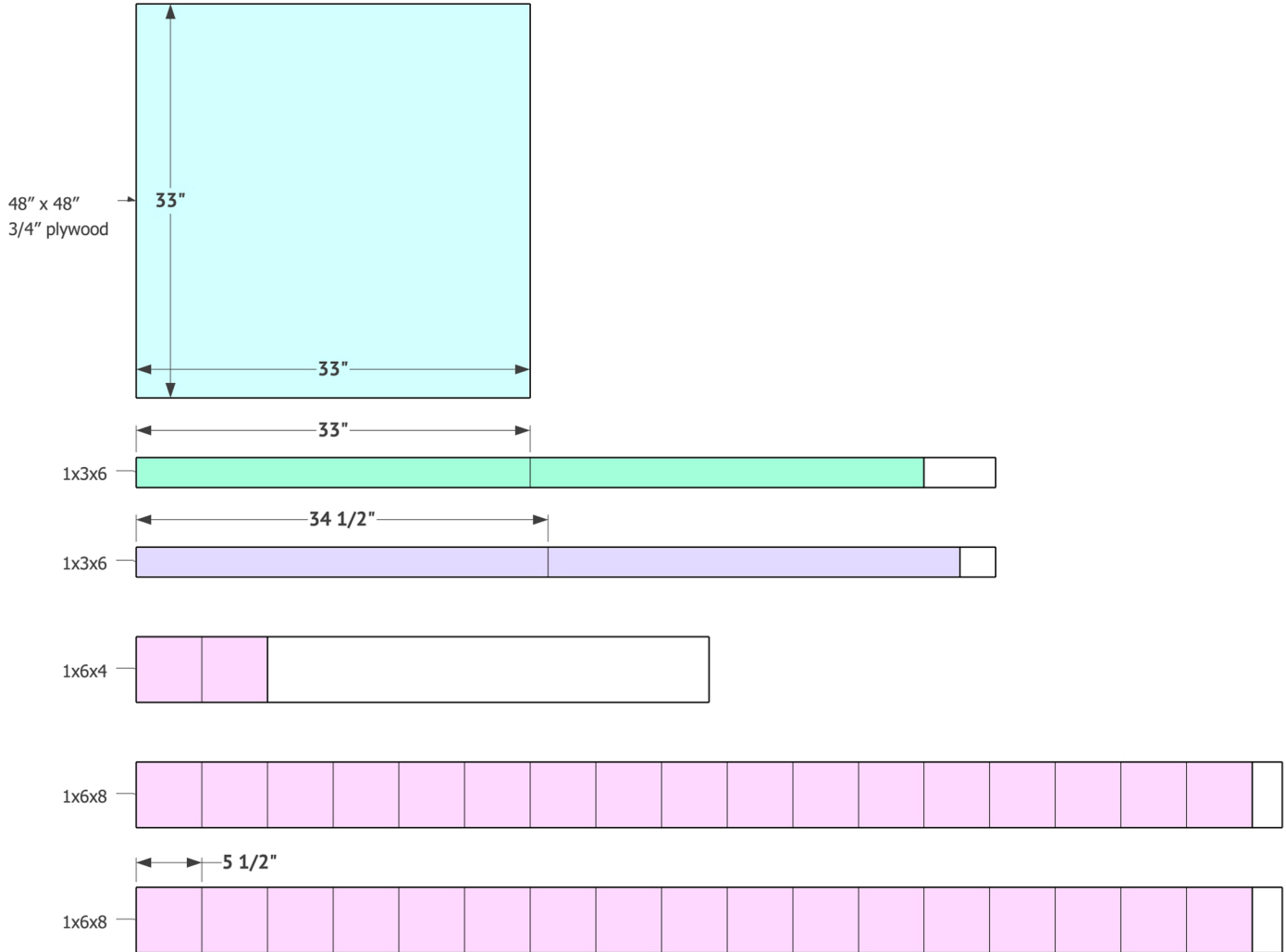

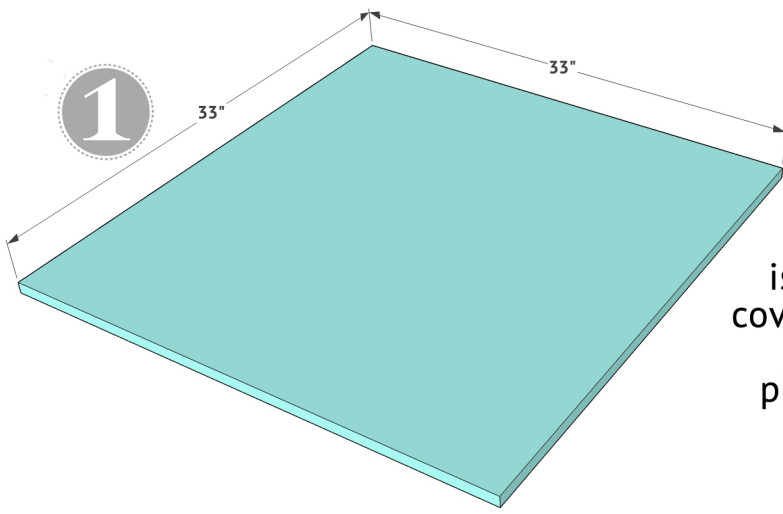

1 x 3 x 6	2	pine or whitewood
3/4" plywood panel	1	48" x 48"
brad nails	several	1.25"

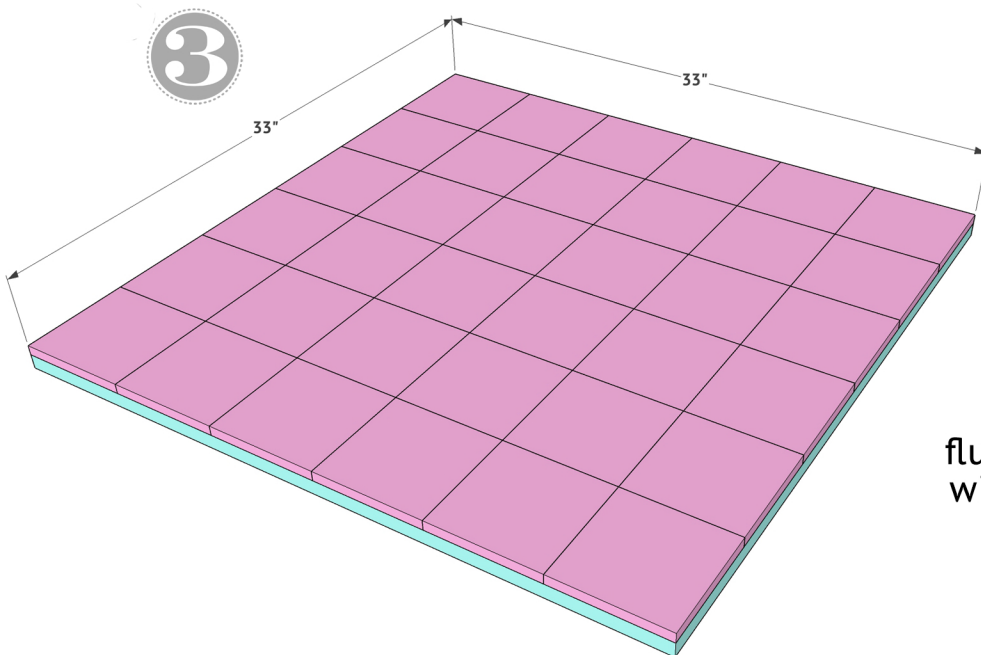
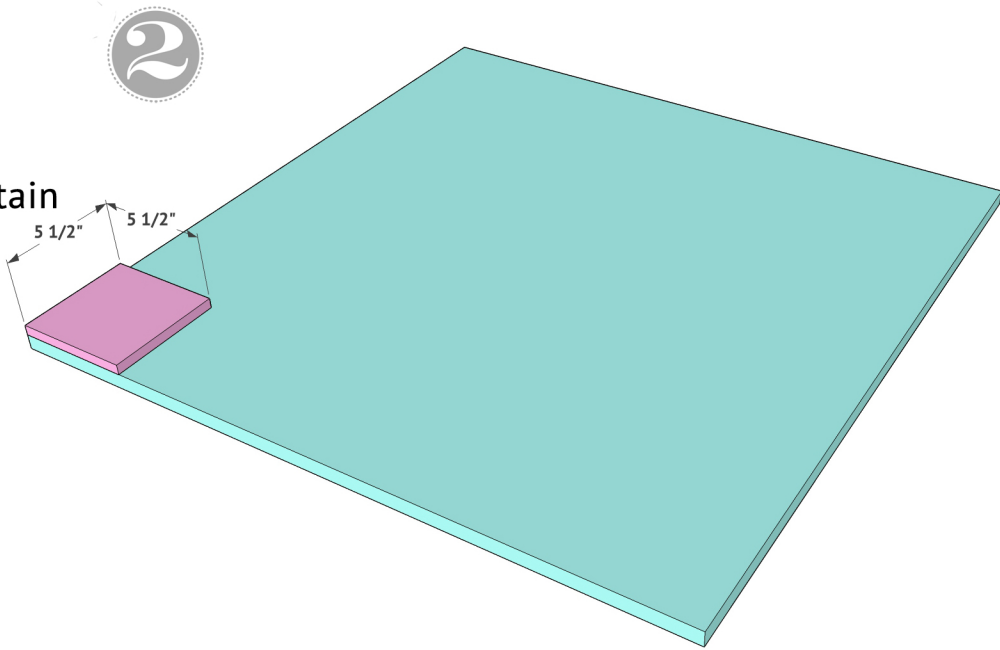

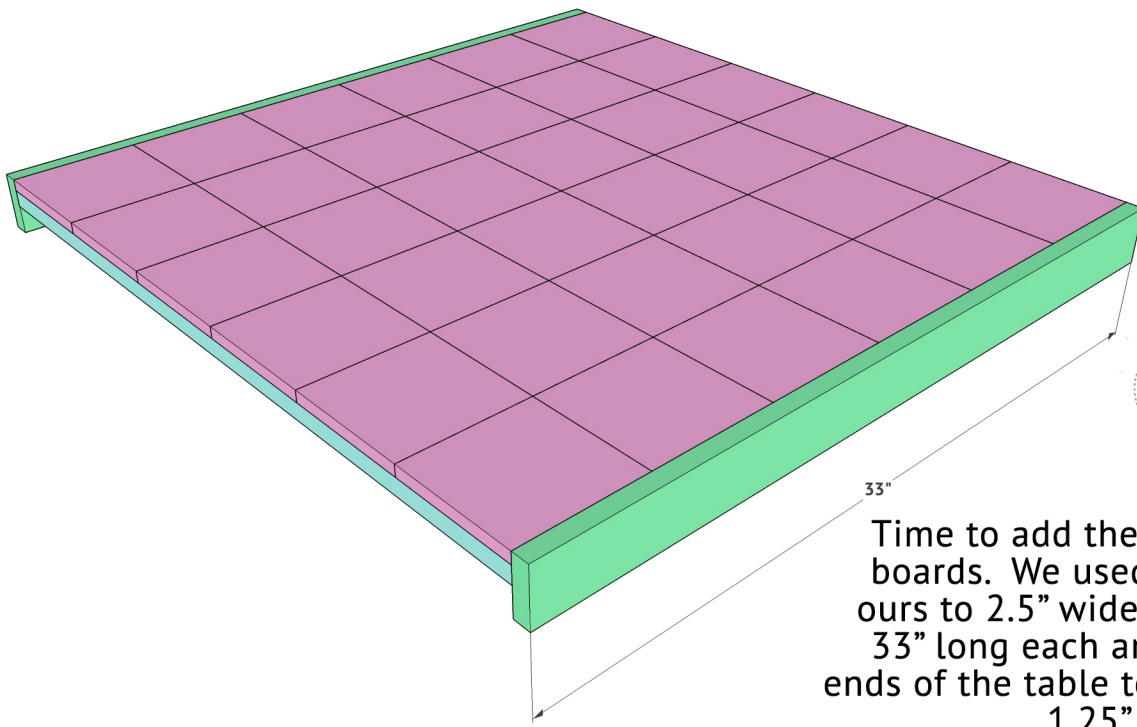


The top of this coffee table is constructed with plywood that is covered in boards. This is 3/4" plywood cut to size. I used the cheapest plywood the hardware store offered.

The top of the table is 1x6 boards cut to squares. Each board is 5.5" x 5.5". You can use any type of wood for this part. Even a 1x6 pine board works perfect, and you can stain it your color of choice. Attach the squares to the plywood using wood glue and 1.25" brad nails.

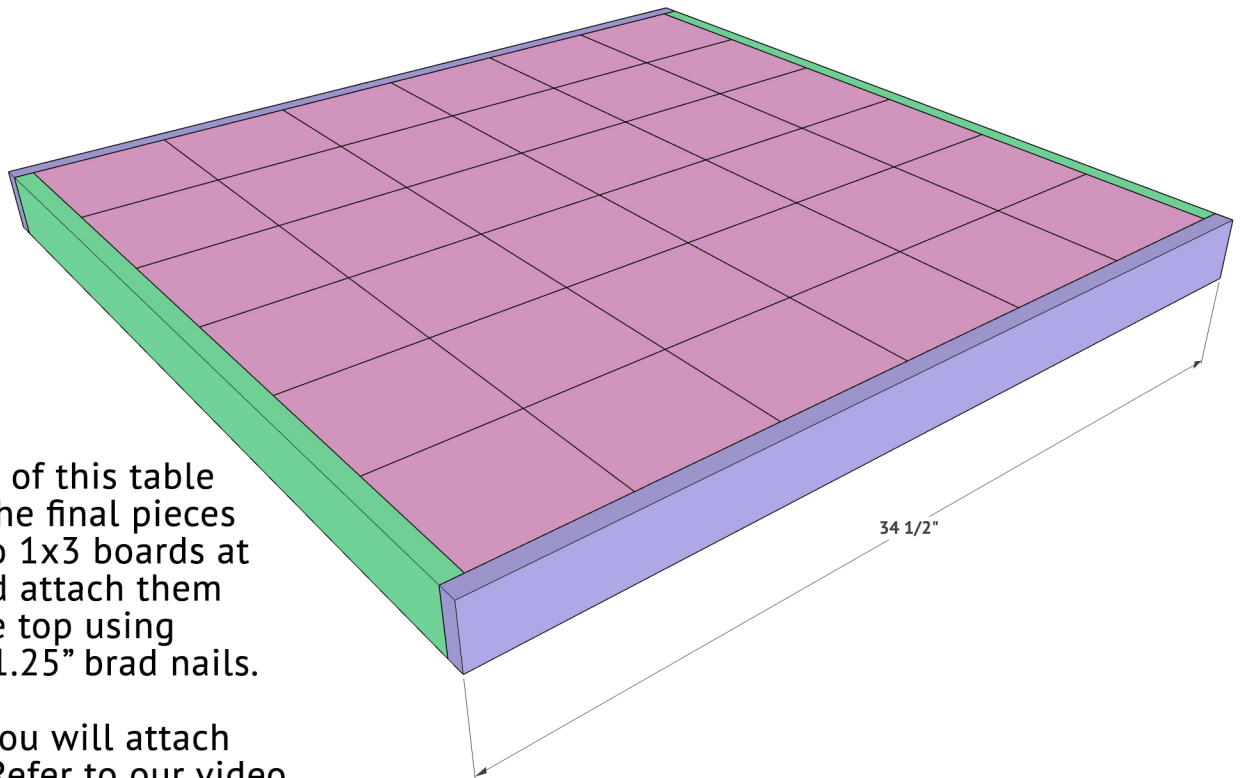


Attach the remaining squares the same way. Make sure each board is flush and next to one another with no spacing between any of the squares.

Time to add the trim! These are 1x3 boards. We used the table saw to rip ours to 2.5" wide each. Cut two 1x3 at 33" long each and attach to opposite ends of the table top using wood glue and 1.25" brad nails.

The final step of this table top is adding the final pieces of trim. Cut two 1x3 boards at 34.5" each and attach them to the table top using wood glue and 1.25" brad nails.

At this point, you will attach your table base. Refer to our video to see how we attached ours!
