





X Door Storage Cabinet


Item	Quantity	Description
3/4" plywood	1	hardwood plywood
1x3x8	1	pine or whitewood
1x4x4	1	pine or whitewood
bender board	2	or craft boards
1/4" hardwood plywood	1	cut to size
edge-glued panel	1	cut to size
1.25" pocket hole screws	several	Kreg Brand
wood glue		
1.25" brad nails		
1/2" brad nails		
hinges	4	refer to post
door pulls	2	refer to post














Build the face frame next. The bottom board is a 1x4 and the sides and top board are 1x3. Add 3/4" pocket holes on bpth sides of the top board and to one end of each side board. Attach all pieces to form a rectangle using wood glue and 1.25" pocket hole screws. Make sure all corners and sides are flush.









Attach the face frame next. Make sure all sides and base are flush and attach using wood glue and 1.25" pocket hole screws through the 3/4" pocket holes on the cabinet.






Attach the top of the cabinet now. I used a 3/4" thick edge-glued panel for my top. Cut it to size and attach using wood glue and 1.25" pocket hole screws through the 3/4" pocket holes on the inside and top of the cabinet.









Now it's time to build the doors to cabinet. The nack of the doors is 1/2" hardwood plywood. Cut them to size.
